Please note the following:

- 1) To be part of the King Kids Team you will be asked to **work hard** and you'll also be asked to **have a lot of fun**. (You'll learn: they go hand in hand)
- 2) During the week of **4 - 8 July** (second week of July school holidays) you **must** be there daily from **7:30 to 14:00**. If you are unable to attend a day you need to discuss it with Carel-J to determine if you can still join the team.
- 3) The other dates you **MUST** be available:
 1. **Friday 1 July. 5pm – 8:30pm**. This is our final training and preparation day.
 2. **Sunday 3 July. 1pm – 6pm** That afternoon we'll get the hall ready.
 3. **Friday evening. 8 July. 4:00pm – 21:00** (about). KKW Final Evening!
- 4) There will be some **voluntary** (you really want to miss out?) **activities some afternoons or evenings**, like the annual put-put competition, braai, etc. These will be **just** for the team.
- 5) Lunch will be provided for you for free (i.e. mahala)
- 6) **NB Note:** Please complete the attached form and get it to me by **Tuesday 10th May**. Note: **No** late forms will be accepted.

- 2) Be a **Christian example** to the younger children. If you're not, you'll be asked to go home. Act appropriately. (E.g. no bad jokes, teasing, foul language, favouritism, etc.)
- 3) No love relationship are allowed to form between team members during KKW. (It's KKW, not your own personal dating service ☺)
- 4) If you are already in a relationship, that relationship must not be visible during KKW (i.e. no holding hands, kissing, hugging, drooling, etc. You're there to focus on the kids.)
- 5) No cell phone usage (i.e. sms, whatsapp, games, instagram, tinder etc) during KKW time.
- 6) No standing on the side as a spectator. Be involved. Mingle with the kids. Have fun!
