Please note the following:



- 1) **Must be a Jesus-follower.** To be part of the crew, you need to be a follower of Jesus. Which means you don't just say you're a Christian, You live like a Christian! You love Jesus. You spend time with Him, etc.
- 2) **Hard work.** To be part of the KKW Crew is hard work. Rewarding work, but hard work. By signing up you agree that you will not be lazy and you will give your everything.
- 3) **Dates:** KKW is from **17-21 June** and you have to be there every day from **7:30 to 14:00**.
- 4) **Other compulsory dates:** You **MUST** be available these dates too. (If you have a problem, discuss with Carel-J)

 6. **Friday evening. 21 June. 4:00pm – ±21:00.** KKW Final + milkshakes afterwards
- 5) **Even more events.** There will be some voluntary (i.e. not compulsory, but do you really want to miss out?) activities some afternoons or evenings (like e.g. braai, photo challenge, etc.) These will be just for the team. No friends or boy/girl friends allowed. Spouses and children are allowed.
- 6) **Lunch.** Lunch will be provided for you for free (i.e. mahala)
- 7) **Indemnity form.** If you are younger than 18, your parents must complete the indemnity form.
